

JOB SUMMARY

The Port of Tacoma is seeking a pool of qualified candidates for the positions of Relief Operations Superintendent. These positions will be responsible for the movement of cargo through the Port of Tacoma; for planning and coordinating labor and equipment requirements at marine terminal facilities; for maintaining communications with cargo and ocean carrier customers and their agents, U.S Customs officials, USDA, USCG, Tugboat operations, the Port's customer service and maintenance departments; for performance of supervisory duties and responsibilities; and for cost analysis and rate development support. These are on-call positions with no guarantee of hours. These positions are not eligible for benefits. The Port of Tacoma is a 24/7 operation and successful candidates must be able to work any shift, including weekends. Hourly rate is \$37.00/hr.

QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE:

A Bachelors Degree from a Maritime Academy or in the business with specialization in transportation or related discipline. We would prefer individuals with at least five (5) years as a stevedore maritime agent or railroad operations. Experience working with cargo related labor force and shipping agent is required. Experience supervising and knowledge of hazardous materials regulations is also required.

EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY
